

You can also upload the cover letter and any supplementary material (optional). Also, it is mandatory to provide a “Declaration of competing interests” statement. This can be done by either checking

the box “I confirm that no authors (...)” or by uploading a file with the statement (in case there are competing interests to declare), with the appropriate selection in the dropdown menu.
